

ORAL ORDER: Having reviewed the parties' recent letters (see, e.g., C.A. No. 12-1595 D.I. 219, 220, 221), IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Arendi's request to set trial dates (and potentially up to seven week-long trials four weeks apart beginning in the fall of 2021) is DENIED. While it is true that these cases are "long-pending," it is also true that the current (jointly-proposed) schedule does not set trial dates and that it is reasonable and appropriate to defer scheduling any trials in these related matters until after case-dispositive motions are resolved. At that time, and after conferring with the parties, the Court will set at least a single trial and no more than two trials, deferring the scheduling of any additional trials until after completion of at least one trial.
